President's Report 2019-20

(NB – As our AGM did not take place in August 2020 owing to the Corona Virus restrictions, this report is being submitted now with our accounts. LGN 28.1.21)

This year began normally with our production of Over My Dead Body by Derek Benfield in the last week of November. Audiences were good and the performance of the play was well received. This comedy portrayed a widower who wished to live the remainder of his life alone in peace. His late wife's forward planning attempted to thwart this leading to many unexpected and comedic moments. Despite audience enjoyment, it has been noted that it may be time to steer away from morbid themes in future as our last two plays have featured bereavement.

Sadly, in the midst of life we are in death and nothing has highlighted this more than the Corona Virus Pandemic of 2020. Global events took over in the early months of the year and, due to the Club's demographic, we suspended Club activities in February prior to the national lockdown in March.

At the end of 2019 we had a representative from the Theatre Royal in Dumfries visit our theatre to assess our lighting with a view to updating our system. We also have had our heating system assessed by a local electrician to enable us to upgrade our heaters with more cost effective ones.

Our theatre was to be a location for The Spring Fling in May and we would have been hosting an exhibition of Bella Green's work but that was obviously cancelled.

In June we received a donation of £10000 from the local Council for Covid measures to help with the running costs of the theatre during closure.

It is hoped the situation improves in the coming months and Lockerbie Little Theatre can be operational again soon.

Recruitment and Appointment of Trustees

The Trustees of the Club are the members of its Committee. They are elected at the Annual General Meeting that takes place in August/September each year.

Governing Document

The Association is a charitable unincorporated association and the purposes and administration arrangements are set out in our Constitution.

Charitable Purposes

Our objectives are set out in our Constitution. They are to provide opportunities for local people to have access to drama through the performance of plays and the holding of play readings.

Trustee Remuneration and Expenses

Committee members received no monies as a result of their membership of the committee. Where members of the Club make payments on behalf of the Club, they are reimbursed on presentation of an appropriate receipt.

Activities and Achievements

The 2019/2020 Season began with a flurry of activity as the upgrading of the theatre building was undertaken, with funding obtained during the previous season (2018/19). New double-glazed window units and a solid rear entrance door were put into the dressing room area. Extensive re-painting of both the interior and exterior of the theatre was also completed.

The Drama Club produced a full length play, "Over my Dead Body" by Derek Benfield, in Autumn 2019. At the beginning of 2020 readings were re-started in order to find a play for production in the Spring. Unfortunately the arrival of the Corona Virus and the complete shut down of theatres across the country meant that the Club had to close the theatre for the foreseeable future. The exhibition of local artist Bella Green's work in May 2020 was also cancelled.

Funds

Although we only produced one full-length play this season, gate receipts were steady for the run of the production, and I shall therefore be recommending that ticket prices stay at £8 and £5 (for 25year olds and under). Subscriptions will also stay the same, with a review as and when the Drama Club is allowed to reconvene its AGM.

In June 2020 a grant of £10,000 from the Local Council was received by the Club to help with running costs during the present pandemic.
