I will be suggesting that ticket prices and subscriptions stay at pre-pandemic levels - namely £8 for a full price ticket and £5 for Members/persons under 25 years of age and £20 for full membership.

The Annual General Meeting in September will allow us to debate the future of the Drama Club.
